The face must be created by combining multiple hands to represent each section of the face. All while being able to show as much detail as possible, and shaded in tonal value with the use of a pencil.

INSTRUCTIONS

SIZE: 10x12in white Bristol drawing paper.

MEDIUM: Pencil. (TONAL SHADING)

- Sketch out the page of different views and formations of hands gestures in order to see each view point from a different angle.
- Research online a variety of facial expressions as well as faces made from hands, for ideas and inspiration.
- Come up with 6 THUMBNAIL SKETCHES exploring different combination ideas for faces created from hands on an 8.5x11in sheet of paper.
- FINAL ILLUSTRATION will be drawn on white card stock and tonally shaded with pencil, showing as much detail and emotion as possible.
