For this assignment students are to create an original eye-catching, interesting Children's Book Cover for a pre-existing children's story. A good cover is able to convey a quick message of what the reader is in store for. The best way to capture an audience is to tell a story in one image by the combination of, title, featured character in an interesting scene, full colour and inked. When illustrating your cover think about the age group or your intended reader. (The age group of the reader: The younger the reader the more simplistic the illustration, the older the reader the more detailed the illustration.)

The first step in creating the perfect cover is to research online different and inspiring examples of children's book covers, reviewing the composition of images, text, title and colour schemes used. Come up with thought out thumbnail sketches. After sketches are complete develop a final cover illustration on 8.5x11in paper, but size your cover to 6x9in. Remember the cover must includes which are found in the instructions.

INSTRUCTIONS

- SIZE: 8.5x11in paper cover sized to 6x9in white drawing paper.
- · MEDIUM: students choosing.
- · Research on line examples of children's book cover illustrations.
- · Select a story that you wish to illustrate.
- Draw 4 rough sketches for your cover giving different ideas to combine.
- Covers MUST include: TITLE, AN INTERESTING SCENE WITH ONE OR MORE CHARACTERS, NAME OF THE AUTHOR AND ILLUSTRATOR. (THIS WOULD BE YOUR NAME)
- Build one of your sketches into the final coloured and inked cover illustration.


